A first-of-its-kind program in a correctional institution, Ford Motor Company provided funding, tools, equipment, and automobiles to build an auto repair training center at Homestead Correctional Institution.

At this all-female facility, offenders are training in auto repair, preparing graduates with necessary life and career skills to better enable them to rejoin society upon release.

## FLAGS FOR FREEDOM

Established in April 2003, Flags for Freedom honors and supports DC officers and employees serving in the Armed Forces.



More than 550 Corrections' employees are on standby or have been deployed to defend freedom in the United States and abroad.
