Louie Wainwright, known as the Dean of American Corrections and the Secretary of the Florida Department of Corrections for 25 years, was appointed as board president in 2001, serving ever since. Our growth began.

Since then, the Corrections Foundation has grown to over 14,000 members, making it possible to provide over \$9.4 million in financial assistance to more than 10,200 FDC officers, staff, and contractors during life's emergencies and natural disasters. Our golf tournaments host 90+ players and over the years have raised more than \$700,000.

We have served as a fiduciary for grants and donations that have supported multiple programs including K-9 tracking, drug interdiction and 20+ dog training, culinary, wellness, chaplaincy and vocational programs throughout the state.

The Corrections Foundation has served as a model for other organizations, including an employee support organization for the Arkansas DOC as well as the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Foundation, a DSO for Florida's Department of Health.

The Corrections Foundation began as a vision in 1995 by former Secretary **Harry Singletary**. He envisioned an organization that would serve a two-fold purpose: to serve as a fiduciary for donations and grants as well as an organization to support the officers and staff of the Florida Department of Corrections (FDC).

The Legislature authorized the creation of a direct support organization (DSO) for FDC, first in the nation for any Department of Corrections and among the first in Florida for a state agency.

Originally called the Foundation for Partnerships in Correctional Excellence was formed in 1996 and the name changed to Corrections Foundation in 2002.

When providing financial assistance to those in need, special casual days had to be held to raise money to provide for those employees in need. Our first golf tournament started with seven teams and was called the Research and Programs Tournament. **Richard Nimer & Bill Bales** with a team of others were instrumental in
